A Maasai community eco-lodge located in Southern Kenya, between Tsavo and Amboseli National Parks, in a private Maasai reserve of 283,000 acres!




## BELIEFS

Our airplane (Cessna 206) or by charter, 1 hour flight from Nairobi (or Mombasa) - 20 minutes from Tanzania (Namanga)

## CAMPI YA KANZI COTTAGES/SUITES

We can accommodate 16 guests in 6 luxury tented cottages and 2 luxury tented suites (The Hemingway and Simba suites), all set on wooden platforms with thatched roofs and large en-suite bathrooms, special ecofriendly flush toilet, shower and bidet. Bedding is of the finest Italian linen. Tents are named after the view from the verandas, from Chyulu Hills to Kilimanjaro.

## KANZI HOUSE & SWIMMING POOL COTTAGE

Now bookable on a per person basis. It has 3 doubles and 1 twin, plus an extra twin next to a double (sharing a bathroom). Featuring a 60ft swimming pool and a Jacuzzi, Kanzi House provides a very private experience. Dining can be arranged either inside or outside. Al fresco dining is available next to the pool or in the open dining area. Guests will be served by dedicated chiefs and waiters. As well as assigned a dedicated safari guide and vehicle.

### WILDERNESS


283,000 acres, we are 2/3 the size of the Maasai Mara reserve (or 20 times Manhattan Island). The Maasai Mara has room for 5,000 tourists, while Campi ya Kanzi has room for just 16 guests. You will enjoy genuine African wilderness in exclusivity, away from the zoo safari experience typical of a National Park.

### LOCATION

You will be in one of the most iconic places for a safari. We are just 30 miles away from 19,341 ft Kilimanjaro, resting on the foothills of the Chyulu Hills (Hemingway's Green Hills of Africa). Lions, elephants, buffaloes, giraffes and all types of antelopes populate the reservation. This is a place you do not want to miss in your safari!

### PERSONAL HOSTING

You will not be in a hotel, but in our home in the bush. 'We' are Luca and Antonella (founders) and the Maasai (landlords of this paradise), and we will be your hosts. All activities will be tailor-made to your desires, from classic game drives in many different habitats, to lovely game walks with your Maasai guide and tracker!

## ITINERARIES

The camp tailors activities to suit each guest's requirements. A minimum of 4 nights is recommended to fully enjoy and explore the rich biodiversity of the area. The connection with the local Maasai landlords is not just profound, but extremely genuine. As the conservation fee per guest per day is paid to the Maasai Wilderness Conservation Trust, guests are seen as benefactors. Walking in the savannah, in the clouds forest, along the river, with a Maasai tracker is an unforgettable experience. Wildlife diversity is extremely rich and landscape beauty impressive.

## CLIMATE

Temperatures are very comfortable year-round, with daytime highs around 90F/33C and night time lows around 60F/15C. The coolest month is July, with January and February being the warmest. During and just after the short rains of November and April/May, the area is particularly beautiful, everything is green and Kilimanjaro is covered with snow. During this period the elephant population is at its peak.
